
# LOCATION & FACILITIES

Chicago Comedy Camps are located in the heart of Old Town, at our Second City Chicago Training Center. Campers will enter under the large marquee at 230 W North Avenue, Chicago IL.

Camp will be lead by expert Second City faculty. We will also have a staff of counselors facilitating the fun and guiding campers from one activity to the next!

Campers will utilize our classrooms on the second floor of the Training Center. The Training Center boasts a massive wall of alumni, multiple classrooms, bleachers and couches for snacks and breaks, stages and MORE.







# CAMP DATES & SESSIONS

The Second City has one-week and advanced three-week camp options available. The following dates are available for <u>7-11 year old age groups</u> and <u>12-18 year old age groups</u>.

# ONE-WEEK CAMPS (AGES 7-11 & 12-18) - \$700

One-week camps will take place Monday - Friday from 9AM - 4PM. Class will culminate with an in-classroom performance at the end of the week, adults will be invited to attend.

# **ADVANCED CAMP (AGES 15-18) - \$1900**

Advanced Comedy Camp is a fully comprehensive 3-week program that dives deep into the skills required to present a Second City-style revue. Curriculum includes training in advanced scenework and long form improv as well as additional lessons in clowning, stand-up, and music improv. Students will present their stand-up material on the second Friday of the program and a one-act sketch revue on the final day.

Prerequisite: must have completed 2 previous camp sessions or 1 year of improv training classes

## DROP OFF/PICKUP

Pick-up and drop-offs will be within assigned time-blocks to best facilitate traffic on North Avenue. All information will be communicated to campers/adults prior to their session start date!

### LUNCH & SNACKS

Students will need to bring a sack lunch every day. We recommend a "cold lunch", as we do not have a fridge for storing lunches. We are a no-nuts building, as many of our students (and staff!) have severe allergies. Students will not be permitted to leave the building to get lunch.

## CLOTHING & MASKS

We recommend comfortable clothing that is freeing to move in! Sneakers or other durable shoes are also recommended. Masks are not required, but are welcome for campers that prefer it. We will have some masks available for campers at request.

## WHAT TO BRING

Please bring your lunch, comfy clothes, and a filled waterbottle, as not all facilities have an easily accessible water fountain. Leave the valuables at home! The Second City cannot be responsible for any lost or stolen items.



#### What is the difference between regular and advanced camps?

Our standard camp offering is for ages 7-11 and 12-18, and lasts one week. No prior experience required! Our advanced camp has a pre-requisite of two prior years of camp sessions or one year of improv training. Advanced camp spans across three weeks. This is great for a student with prior experience!

#### What is your COVID policy?

#### How firm are the age groups?

#### How experienced does my child need to be to participate?

We welcome all kids from all experienve levels. The experience is meant to be explorative, and function as an introduction to materials - beginners are as welcome as seasoned performers.

#### Can I get a recording of my child's performance?

We do not provide recordings of the performances after they take place. We encourage adults to join us for the live show in-person. You are welcome to record the performance from your phone or camera, as long as its not disruptive to the show!
