LOCATION & FACILITIES

Toronto Comedy Camps will take place in our brand new location at One York Street! Campers will enter the One York building and head to The Second City located on the third floor.

Camp will be lead by expert Second City faculty. We will also have a staff of counselors facilitating the fun and guiding campers from one activity to the next!

Campers will utilize our classrooms on the third floor of the One York building, as well as couches and seating in our lobby areas.

Campers will have the opportunity to explore other areas of the building during their lunch break!



CAMP DATES & SESSIONS

The Second City has one-weekcamp options available. The following dates are available for 7-11 year old age groups and 12-18 year old age groups.

DROP OFF/PICKUP

Pick-up and drop-offs will be within assigned time-blocks to best facilitate traffic at One York. All information will be communicated to campers/adults prior to their session start date!

LUNCH & SNACKS

Students will need to bring a sack lunch every day. We recommend a "cold lunch", as we do not have a fridge for storing lunches. We are a no-nuts building, as many of our students (and staff!) have severe allergies.

CLOTHING & MASKS

We recommend comfortable clothing that is freeing to move in! Sneakers or other durable shoes are also recommended. Masks are not required, but are welcome for campers that prefer it. We will have some masks available for campers at request.

WHAT TO BRING

Please bring your lunch, comfy clothes, and a filled waterbottle, as not all facilities have an easily accessible water fountain. Leave the valuables at home! The Second City cannot be responsible for any lost or stolen items.

We welcome all kids from all experience levels. The experience is meant to be explorative, and function as an introduction to materials - beginners are as welcome as seasoned performers.

Can I get a recording of my child's performance?

We do not provide recordings of the performances after they take place. We encourage adults to join us for the live show in-person. You are welcome to record the performance from your phone or camera, as long as its not disruptive to the show!
